Dear Mr. St. Martin:

I am responding to your letter dated July 13, 2008, in which you stated that you had been made aware that several allegations of "predatory and stalking" behavior toward a female staff member had been documented in your chart. You content states that there is a failure by Coalinga State Hospital employees to either protect staff from your alleged abuse or to protect you from staff manipulation. You further allege that on March 29, 2008, a Hospital Police Officer misinterpreted an Administrative Directive and then documented in your chart that you invaded her space and she was in fear for her safety. The last incident in your letter alleges that on September 5, 2007, you were assaulted by a Hospital Police Officer when he informed you that if you did not return to your unit, PMAB would be applied.

I have referred your concerns to Administration at Coalinga State Hospital. They will address your concern and you should be receiving a response from them shortly.

Should you have any additional concerns regarding this issue, please address them to Coalinga State Hospital Administration. At this time, I will consider this issue closed.
